Graduation will be upon you shortly and this is a reminder that all parental obligations (scrip, hours, fees) need to be current by April 30, 2011.

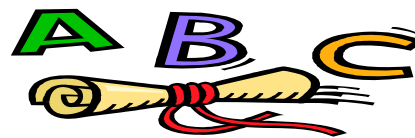
Uniform Exchange:
