

Summer Reading Assignment

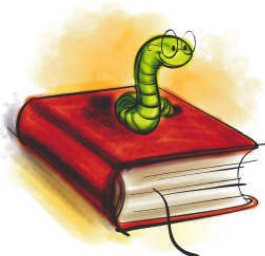

Flashcards are great for this! If you have your basic math facts memorized, you will be ready for third grade. Remember to bring all of your supplies and be sure to have your name on everything.
