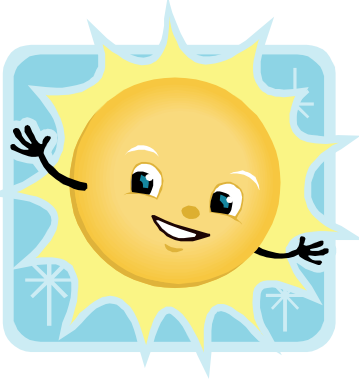
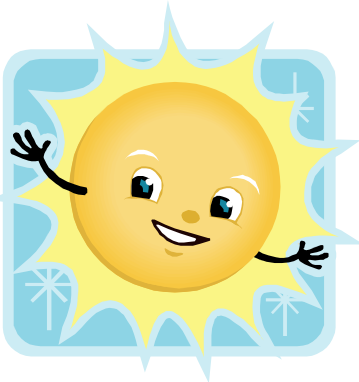

FOURTH GRADE SUPPLY LIST



Here's what you need:

Quantity

- 1 package of wide ruled binder paper
- 3 spiral notebooks (binder paper size)
- 4 pocket folders (pee-chee size)
- 6 #2 pencils with erasers and an eraser
- 1 zip pouch to hold book
- 6 erasable pens (blue or black)
- 1 black **Flair** felt tip marker (must be that brand)
- 2 red pens (not erasable)
- 1 set of fine tip markers
- 1 box of colored pencils
- 1 box of crayons (24 is enough)
- 1 pair of scissors
- 5 glue sticks
- 3 packs of lined index cards (3" x 5") to use during the year
- 1 **small** (4" wide by 8" long) plastic box to store everything
- 2 boxes of Kleenex
- 1 **backpack without wheels**

Don't forget to label everything!!!
