Middle School Supply List

Parents are asked to purchase the following items. Students are asked to have the full set of supplies on the first day of school and every day after that. *Students must be responsible for replacing missing items.* Each middle school teacher will expect students to have the following items and reserves the right to send home anything that is not requested by this list which may become a distraction in the classroom:

- a package of college-ruled binder paper (500 sheets)
- folders and spiral notebooks (college-ruled only) labeled and color-coded as follows:
 - blue folder labeled
 - 1. religion/math
 - blue three subject spiral notebook labeled
 - 1. religion/math
 - red folder labeled
 - 1. Spanish
 - red three subject spiral notebook labeled
 - 1. Spanish
 - black folder labeled
 - 1. English/literature
 - black three subject spiral notebook labeled
 - 1. English/literature
 - green folder labeled
 - 1. science
 - green three subject spiral notebook labeled
 - 1. science
 - yellow folder labeled
 - 1. social studies
 - yellow three subject spiral notebook labeled
 - 1. social studies
 - three folders of your choice labeled
 - 1. music
 - 2. computers
 - 3. binder paper
- a small plastic zip pouch with the following items
 - an eraser
 - a 12" ruler (metric/customary)
 - a protractor
 - a compass
 - a pair of scissors
 - a glue stick
- a set of standard colored pencils
- a set of crayons (16-24 colors only)
- a set of markers (no larger than 16 colors)

- a calculator (one with the basic functions and the capacity to do exponents and roots – a Texas Instrument TI 30X or 34 or 36 or 73 solar is recommended – please do not make the calculator so complicated that students will not know how to use it – *graphing calculators are not necessary*)
- a Bible (the one given to the students in Grade 4)
- a small pocket Thesaurus and Dictionary
- a Spanish/English Dictionary
- four erasable black or blue pens (ballpoints pens are acceptable, but please **no gel pens**)
- two red ballpoint pens
- four sharpened #2 pencils
- a small sharpener
- a roll of scotch tape
- two big boxes of Kleenex

The request for colored-coded spirals and notebooks may seem extreme, but we have done this for the last three years. It is possible – we have supplied the folders and spirals in the past and have shopped at Staples, Office Depot, and Costco. We do this to assist the middle school teachers and the students. A teacher knows at a glance if students are ready for his/her subject. It also assists the students with organizational skills. Please – abide by the colors. Plain folders with two pockets are fine; the sturdier each folder is the better.

Students are asked not to use binders or white out. Correction tape is acceptable. We appreciate your cooperation and support as we continue to make our students' middle school experience a positive one.
